

1. **First Amendment:** -Freedom of religion, speech, press, assembly  
-Petition the government for a redress of grievances
2. **Second Amendment:** -A well regulated Militia and the right of people to bear arms shall not be infringed
3. **Third Amendment:** -No soldier shall be quartered in a house without the owner's consent in time of peace or war
4. **Fourth Amendment:** -People have the right to prevent search and seizures without a warrant  
-Warrants issued upon probable cause allow a person or specific place to be searched
5. **Fifth Amendment:** -No person shall be held to answer for a capital unless on a presentment or indictment of a Grand Jury  
-No person shall be subject for the same offense to be twice put in jeopardy of life  
-No person shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself  
-No person shall be deprived of life, liberty or property without due process of law  
-Private property shall not be taken for public use without compensation
6. **Sixth Amendment:** -Accused shall have a right to a speedy and public trial by an impartial jury of the State and district where the crime was committed
7. **Seventh Amendment:** -Civil trial by jury
8. **Eighth Amendment:** -Excessive bail or excessive fines shall not be required/imposed  
-No cruel and unusual punishments shall be inflicted
9. **Ninth Amendment:** -The enumeration in the Constitution, of certain rights, shall not be construed to deny or disparage others retained by the people  
-Every citizen is protected by the rights not directly stated in the Constitution
10. **Tenth Amendment:** -Powers not delegated to the US by the Constitution are reserved to the states or to the people
11. **Eleventh Amendment:** -Judicial power of the US shall not be construed to extend to any suit in law or equity  
-Judicial power shall not be commenced or prosecuted against one of the US by citizens of another state  
-Original jurisdiction of the Supreme Court when one state is taking another to court
12. **Twelfth Amendment:** -President and VP are chosen by the Electoral College  
-VP must be eligible to become President  
-In choosing the President, the votes shall be taken by states, the representation from each state having one vote  
-If the House shall not choose a President whenever the right of choice shall devolve upon them, before the fourth day of March, then the VP shall act as President if he cannot
13. **Thirteenth Amendment:** -Neither slavery nor involuntary servitude shall exist within the US  
-Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate legislation
14. **Fourteenth Amendment:** -All persons born or naturalized in the US are citizens of the US and of the state where they reside  
-No state shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of US citizens  
-No state shall deprive any person of life, liberty, or property without due process of law  
-No state shall deny to any person the equal protection of laws  
-Representatives shall be apportioned among the states according to their population  
-Slaves no longer added to the census as 3/5  
-US does not pay the debts of rebellious states
15. **Fifteenth Amendment:** -The right of citizens of the US to vote shall not be denied due to race  
-Man of every race has the right to vote
16. **Sixteenth Amendment:** -Congress shall have power to lay and collect taxes on incomes
17. **Seventeenth Amendment:** -The Senate shall be composed of 2 Senators from each state  
-Elected by the people of their state and have 6 year terms
18. **Eighteenth Amendment:** -Alcohol is abolished
19. **Nineteenth Amendment:** -Women have the right to vote
20. **Twentieth Amendment:** -President and VP terms end at noon on January 20  
-Senator & Representative terms end at noon on January 3
21. **Twenty-First Amendment:** -Alcohol no longer banned
22. **Twenty-Second Amendment:** -President may only serve two terms
23. **Twenty-Third Amendment:** -Electors are equal to number of Senators and Representatives in Congress
24. **Twenty-Fourth Amendment:** -Citizens may still vote if they fail to pay any taxes
25. **Twenty-Fifth Amendment:** -VP takes the President's job if he cannot continue
26. **Twenty-Sixth Amendment:** -Anyone over 18 may vote
